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DPSPR has an ever evolving system encompassing various activities and experiences in school. We remain committed to providing an activity based integrated learning environment to our students and prepare them to keep pace with the changing times. We offer activity based, well curated composite curriculum for Nursery and Prep specially designed to build concepts in a graded progressive manner based on the Reggio Emilia Approach.

Art, music, theatre, technology and sports are interwoven into the daily program to foster the development of scientific aptitude, language and numeracy skills. The curriculum champions self-discovery, appreciates unique talent among children and builds a community of individual and collective excellence. It supports academic rigour through project-based and experiential learning.

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Physical Education is an integral part of our school curriculum. Learners enjoy the facility of two huge play fields and eight playing stations. Sports that we offer are cricket, football, Volleyball, basketball, table-tennis, chess, carrom, taekwondo, gymnastics and yoga. In addition to the development of sports skills, important lessons of team cum competitive spirit and time management are also provided for a holistic growth.

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We connect the concepts of curriculum with day -to-day life experiences and engage our children with learning -by- doing methods to enhance better grasping.

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Our model of education is proven and time tested. Like all DPS schools, we deliver quality education with strong emphasis on academic excellence as well as all round development of the child to succeed in the modern world.

- Four Computer Labs, two EVS Labs, Math Labs, Atal Tinkering Labs, Science, and other subject labs.
- Two Libraries in the Junior and Senior Wings.
- Separate Indian and Western Music and Dance Rooms.

- Football ground, Basketball court, Badminton court.
- For the emotional well- being of students, the school has two trained counsellors who offer personal as well as career counselling to the students.
- In addition, two special educators are at hand to help students with learning difficulties or impairments. Parents are welcome to consult them for advice and assistance.
- Sensory/Science park for the students of Pre- Primary and Primary Wing. It is an exclusive play space designed to meet the physical, sensory, motor and social needs of our students.

 A dedicated Learning Centre is also there to provide remedial support and occupational therapy to children with specific learning disabilities.
